Dear Mr F,

I have read your email to my friend Tayo and his response to you. I think I should also reply.

Yes, I am from a Jewish family. We lived in Budapest during WWII – and a few of us survived.

To me, Israel is a disgrace. It behaves towards Palestinians pretty much as the Nazis behaved towards Jews. Jews have no 'right' to the land their ancestors inhabited thousands of years ago. Do you think all Dutch/French/British/Hungarian/African/etc-Americans or Spanish-Brazilians/et al should return to the lands of their ancestors and displace those living there now?

And yes, I am also against the USA for its support of Israel and its donation of nuclear weaponry to it. (And also for the ongoing racial discrimination there.)

If we are to accept a Jewish state which discriminates against some of its population and thinks it has the right to seize others' land, then we should also accept states under Sharia laws.

Israel, to me, is not only a disgrace, but a tragedy.
